### History and progress of the Convent:

In December 1967 Mother Theodosia, the Superior General bought the plot and the buildings once used by Peirce Leslie and Co. Mother Theodosia named it Ashaniketan, a home of hope for the Postulants. The 56 postulants moved into Ashaniketan from Mayhill in 1967. In 1971 small boarders were admitted. In September 1977, Carmel centre was established for the education of women, a centre for non formal education. Ashaniketan extends hospitality and service to boarders and guests to this day. In August 1979 a Chapel was installed at Ashaniketan and it was renamed as 'Carmel Convent' on January 10, 1980. Sr. M. Vera A.C was the 1<sup>st</sup> superior.
